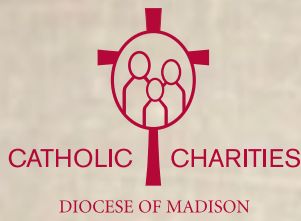

• SENIOR SERVICES

222 volunteers provided 9,000+ hours of respite care to 241 seniors in 18 congregations last year

• CHILDREN

86% of school age children learned to get along better with their classmates as a result of our group counseling

• INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES

96% of clients in family counseling function better at home, work or school as a result of our counseling services

• PERSONS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

Annually, we provide services to over 1,500 developmentally disabled persons

• PERSONS WITH ALCOHOL AND DRUG ADDICTION

On average, 95% of clients with drug or alcohol abuse problems find jobs and permanent housing and 85% remain drug free after our program



Adoption Catholic Charities has been building families through adoption since 1946. We are here to help women and men facing an unplanned pregnancy and bring infants and parents together.



Developmental Disabilities We provide persons with disabilities daily social, leisure, and recreational activities and enable them to live as independently as possible.



Mobile Food Pantries Since 2005, we have been helping rural communities by providing for basic needs through our Parish Mobile Food Pantry. Last year, 563 tons of food was delivered to 11 different parish sites serving over 48,000 people.



Elderly Services Our Aging Programs assist older persons so they can continue to live independently in their own homes and remain active in the community.

- We offer aging persons community living at our All Saints Neighborhood. The Neighborhood consists of apartment homes, cottages, condos, and an assisted living and memory care facility, located near the Bishop O'Connor Center. (Serving 249 in 2010)
- We manage Hope Haven-Rebos United serving Dane and Marquette Counties. Hope Haven-Rebos United programs focus on persons experiencing alcohol and drug abuse issues who need residential treatment. (Served over 400 in 2009)

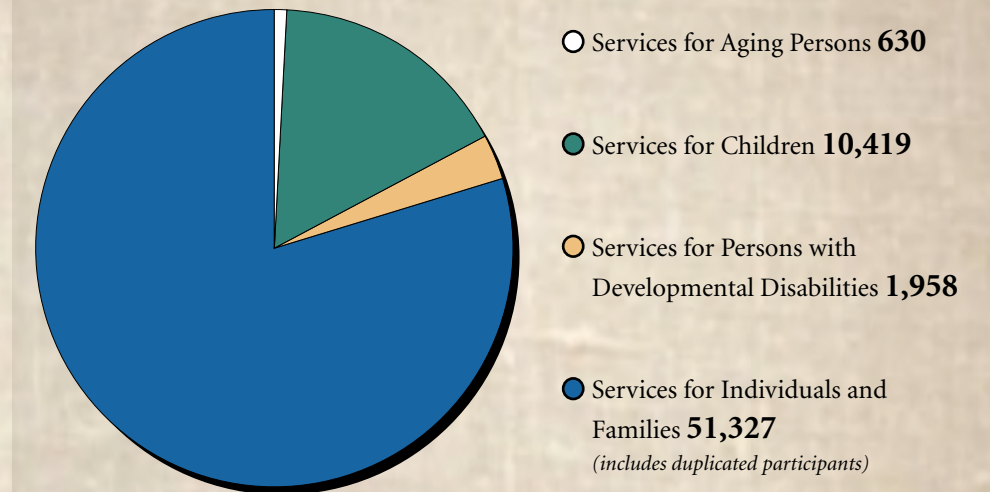
