DART

The Dane County Day Report and Treatment Program is a pre-trial, bail monitoring program for drug abusing offenders. This program is provided in collaboration with the Mental Health Center of Dane County and the Dane County Human Services. The program provides comprehensive alcohol and other drug addictions, mental health, and case management services. Clients are referred by the Dane County courts.

MARQUETTE CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY SERVICE (MCDS)

A private, state-certified, nonprofit program providing alcohol and other drug abuse treatment and prevention services to the residents of Marquette County through a contract with the Marquette County Human Services Board. Services offered include crisis intervention, individual and group counseling, outreach, information and referral, assessments, and case management.

PATHFINDER

A unique jail diversion option which provides comprehensive, long-term treatment for adult offenders with alcohol and other drug problems, especially those whose history of relapse has contributed to jail recidivism. The program combines intensive services, electronic monitoring, and an individualized “wrap around” approach that addresses substance abuse, addiction issues, criminal behavior and other barriers to change.
